**MECOSTA COUNTY PARKS
MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

For the sole purpose of funding the Mecosta County Parks Commission Capital Improvement Plan, including developing, maintaining, equipping, improving and making capital expenditures for Mecosta County Parks, shall the Constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Mecosta, Michigan, be increased by up to 0.5000 of one (1) mill, (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), for a period of five (5) years, 2016 through 2020, inclusive?

If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$623,417 for the Mecosta County Parks Commission parks in the first calendar year of the levy. In accordance with State law, a small portion of the millage may also be disbursed to the Downtown Development Authority of Wheatland Township; the Tax Increment Finance Authority of the City of Big Rapids; and the Brownfield Redevelopment Authorities of the City of Big Rapids and Mecosta County.
